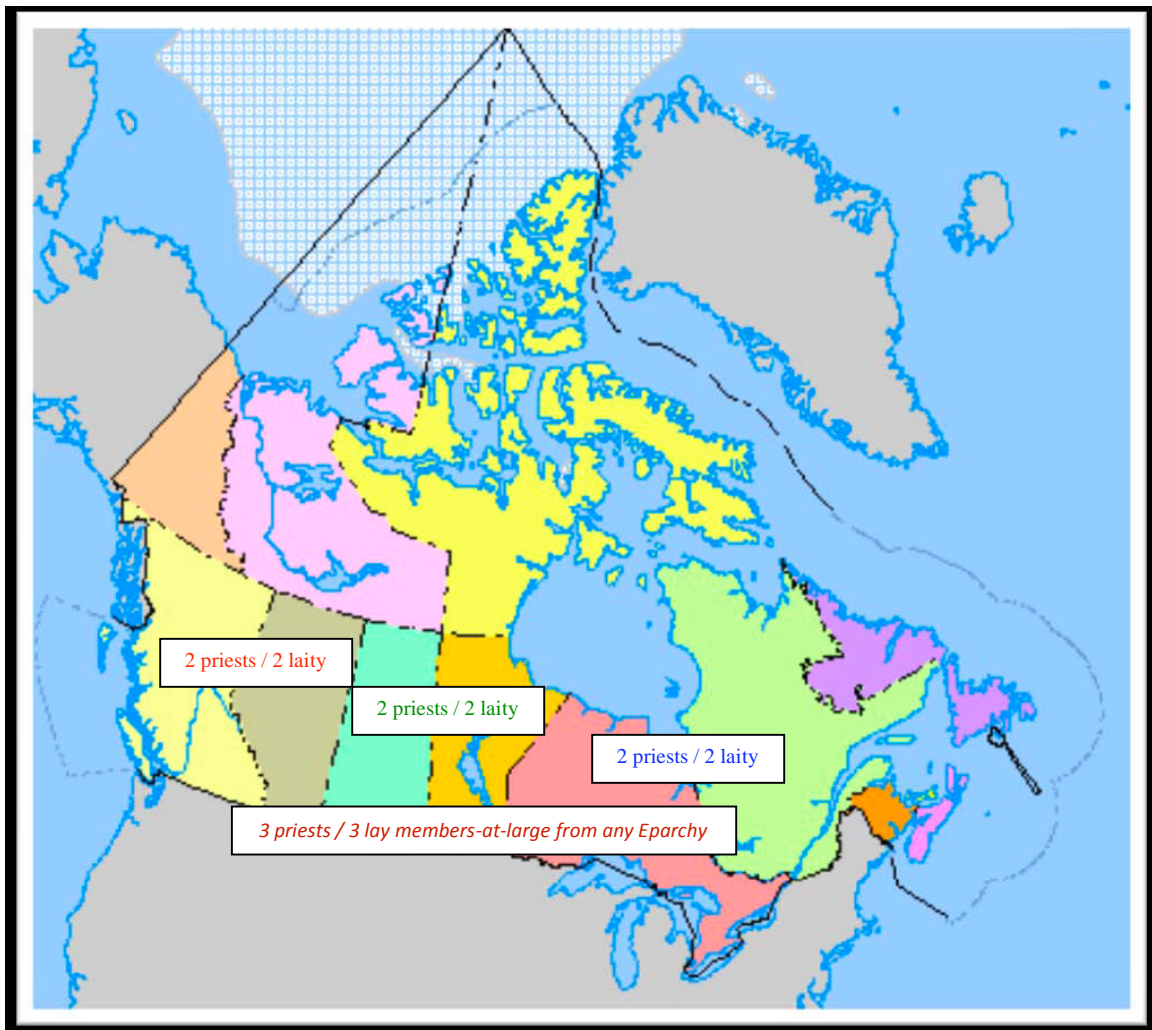

SOBOR 2010 Nominating Committee



The 21st SOBOR of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church of Canada adopted the following motion: Moved /Seconded by M. Kopola /A.Kachkowski: that it be resolved for the next SOBOR that the Consistory Board be elected as follows: two clergy and two laity representatives per Diocese, and three clergy and three laity be elected as members-at-large. *Carried.*

Article 11:6 of the Revised By-laws of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church of Canada states: "The composition of the Consistory Board shall be such that no fewer than two priests and two lay persons residing in each eparchy of the Church shall be elected to the Board."

One of the priest representatives is elected as Chancellor of the U.O.C.C. The Chancellor elected may not necessarily be a resident of the Central Eparchy.

In respect to the election process, interpretation of the 21st SOBOR Resolution and Article 11.6 is as follows, subject to the Chancellor being elected as one of the priests-at-large. Once the voting had taken place and the votes counted – the two priests and two lay persons with the most votes, from each respective Eparchy, are elected as the Eparchy Representatives. The remaining two priests and three lay persons with the most votes received will be elected as members at large for the remaining positions on the Full Board. This process would give each Eparchy at least two priest and two lay representatives. The remaining six positions (*one being the Chancellor*) are elected at large from all of Canada.

In addition to the election of members to the Consistory Board, elections will take place for members to the:

Internal Audit Committee (3 members – one priest and two lay persons and 2 alternatives – 1 priest and 1 lay person),

Church Court (3 members – two priests & one lay person and 2 alternatives – one priest and one lay person) and

St. Andrew's College Board (9 members- presented by St. Andrew's College to the Sobor Nomination Committee).

Nomination Forms for Chancellor and Consistory Board Members – May be obtained by candidates through the members of the Nomination Committee in your Eparchy or from the UOCC web page.
